*Silence for reflection and self-examination.*

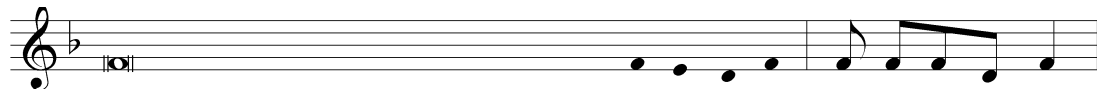
